IALA (International Association of Lighthouse Authorities) IALA - B, Buoy System. For these questions the student should use Light List Volume I (Blue Pages) and Volume II (Yellow Pages). The Blue pages contain much more details. There are a wide variety of Navigation General questions, both Oceans and Near Coastal that are created from information found in the Light List books. It is in the student's best interest to spend time learning to navigate these books efficiently. The following questions are examples of USCG Deck Questions whose answers can be found using Light List book.

These sample questions are provided to help direct the student on how to look through several areas of the Light List books. We encourage them to write down notes and gain insight for similar questions as they prepare for their license exam. Remember, the page number of the "physical" copy will not be the same page number as the "digital" copy. 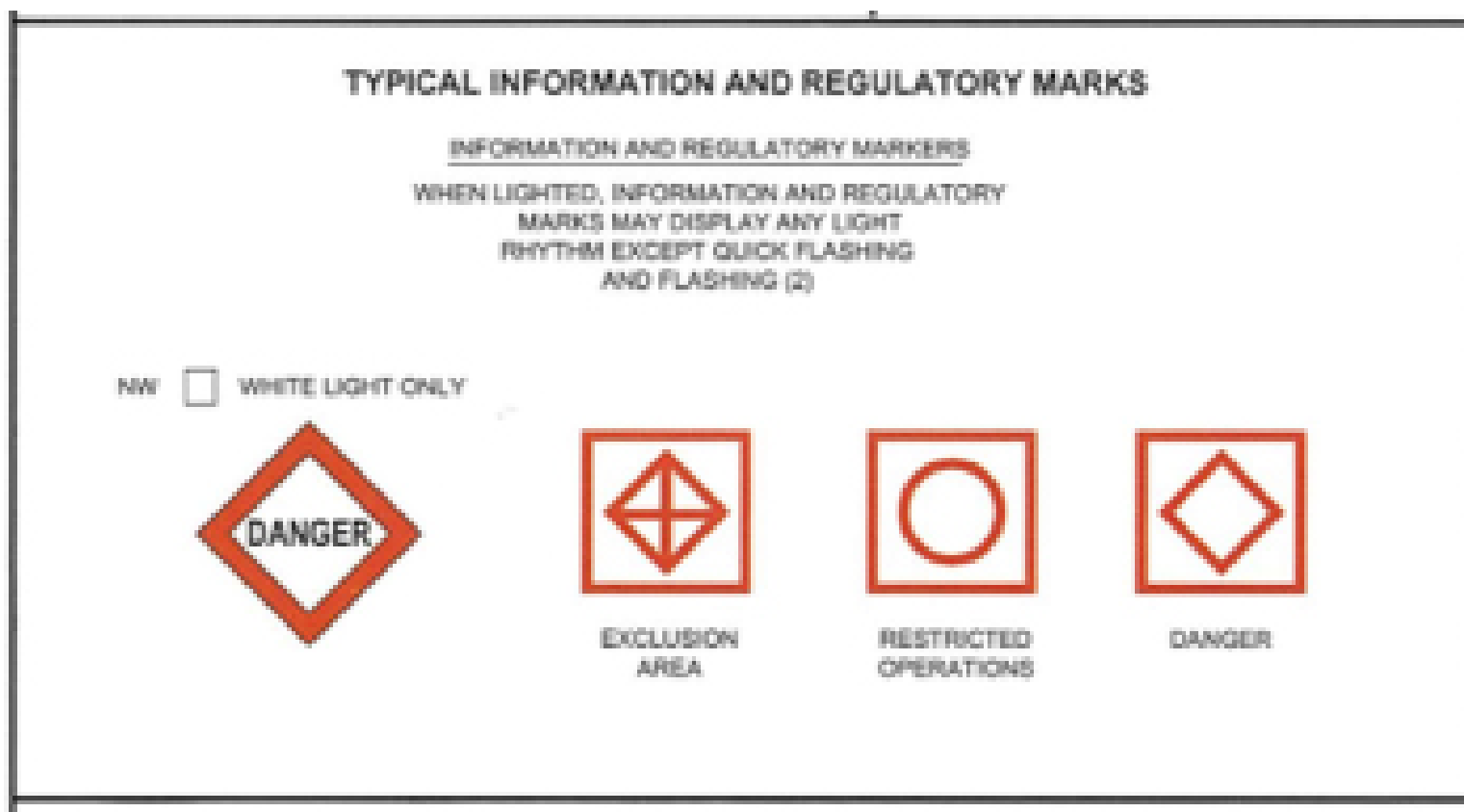

White and orange buoys, if lighted, show which color light?

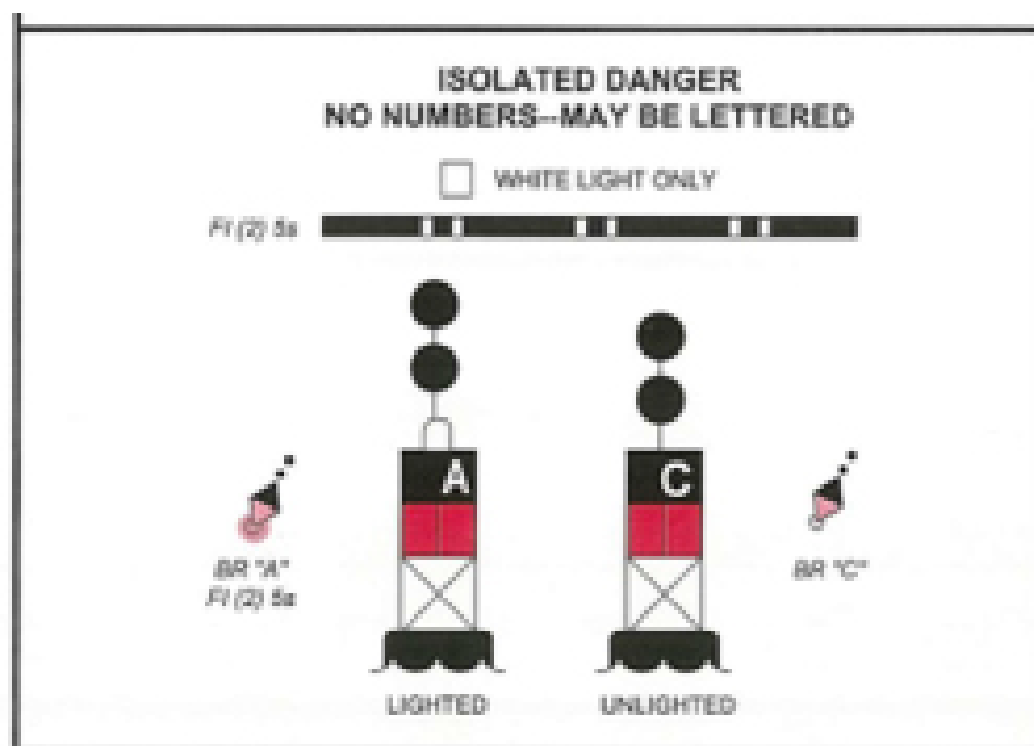
